- Successfully demand for freedom for **112 Owerri women who were indiscriminately arrested** by the Nigerian Police.
- Successfully demand for freedom for **Premium Times Journalist, Samuel Ogundipe** who was indiscriminately arrested by the Nigerian Police.
- **Continuous advocacy on Kemi Adeosun's NYSC forgery allegation** which eventually led to her resignation.

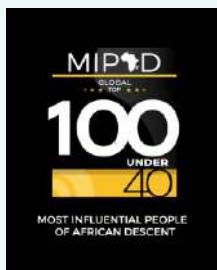

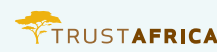
